## Updates

- **HITRUST certification of HiPerGator**
  - Frazier & Deeter submitted the validated assessment report to the HITRUST Alliance for review on schedule today March 20, 2023.
  - F&D and HITRUST will have a review session in the week of April 7.
  - Then HITRUST will work on the report, which is expected early May.
  - The documentation for the PHI and FERPA process has been published on the RC website <https://rc.ufl.edu> -> Documentation, under “Policies” and under “Procedures”, and under “Frequently Asked Questions”. The Archer screens have been updated. Other websites have added a link to these pages to make sure faculty can find this information.
  - A communication plan will be executed in the next few weeks to spread the news.
